Dispatch advised that a b/m driver had entered a black Ford Ranger, traveling towards Oakwood Blvd. The Officer was close to the scene and had observed a black pickup truck traveling south on Fairlane Dr. towards Outer Dr. The Officer then identified the truck as an older model Chevrolet Silverado, driven by a white male and white female. The Officer checked the area with assistance but was unable to locate the Ford Ranger. The Officer made contact with Loss Prevention who had called 911. They stated that the male suspect had entered the store through the grocery doors and immediately walked towards the clothing area where the Carhartt products were. She stated she observed the male grab 4 Carhartt jackets and 2 Carhartt hoodies, then start to walk towards the exit of the store, completely bypassing the checkout. She stated that she told the male to stop, but he ignored her, continuing through the doors and outside toward the black Ford Ranger. She stated that she was unable to get a license plate from the vehicle. She stated that she would complete a store report and provide surveillance footage to detectives as they wished to pursue charges. The Officer gave her a card with the case number and advised her to get in contact with the Detective Bureau the next business day.

An Officer arrived and made contact with the victim who stated that her wallet was stolen at the Aldi's Grocery Store (23035 Outer Dr.). She stated that she was at Aid i's with a friend of hers and had just paid for her groceries. Once arriving at her vehicle in the parking lot, she observed that her handbag was not on her person or in her grocery cart. Her daughter stated that the wallet had been shown at a residence and they advised her and her daughter to contact Detroit PD to assist them in recovering the wallet. The Officer also advised her to cancel her debit/bank cards (which she stated she already had) and to change the locks on her house as she believed her house keys were in the handbag. The Officer asked if she wanted to pursue charges against the thief, which she advised if she gets her property back, she does not want to press charges. The Officer advised the report would be turned over to the Detective Bureau and she could follow up with a Detective the next day.

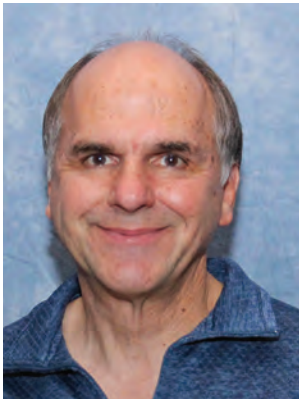
