WAYNE COUNTY MAINTENANCE PROJECT 2024 - NORTH BRANCH OF ECORSE CREEK DRAIN

From: City of Allen Park Government

\$10 million in Wayne County ARPA funds for drain maintenance will effect 16.3 miles of the North Branch of Ecorse Creek Drain.

The project scope will consist of clearing trees/obstructions, sediment removal and bank stabilization that will effect land owners, MDOT, the Railroad and Wayne County located in seven cities.

There will be a "Reach" mailing from Wayne County to parcel owners which consists of 114 residents



If you receive mail regarding this project, it is because work will be performed on, or near, your property.

Encroachments such as a fence, building, landscaping, structures or driving/walking surface cannot be within 30 feet of the drain.

If you receive information from Wayne County about this project in the mail, it is important that you use the parcel number that is provided and take their survey.

Why did I receive this letter?
Under the leadership of Wayne County Executive Warren C. Evans, the Wayne County Drain Commissioner received a \$10 million grant to perform work on the North Branch of Ecorse Creek Drain. You received this notice because you own property along the Drain. Work will be performed on the Drain, which will take place on or near your property.

What is the North Branch of Ecorse Creek Drain?
The North Branch of Ecorse Creek Drain is a county drain under the jurisdiction of the Wayne County Drain Commissioner. It was established as a county drain in 1861. The Drain is 16.3 miles long.

What is a county drain?
A drain is infrastructure that is used to convey or hold stormwater or rain. It can include things such as:

- Storm sewers or pipes
- Ditches or open drains
- Detention ponds
- Rivers, streams, creeks, and/or wetlands

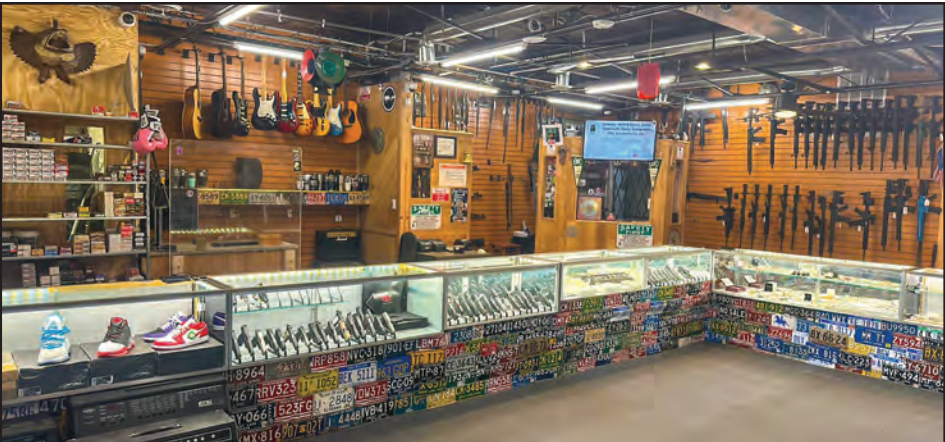
Wayne County has easement rights on all properties where the Drain is located to perform work.

Will the work impact my sanitary sewer?
No. The North Branch of Ecorse Creek Drain carries stormwater. It does not carry sanitary waste and does not have connections to homes for sanitary sewer.

What work is being done?
Work will include basic maintenance activities that may include removing trees, sediment, and debris. The work will take place within the Drain and along the edge of the Drain. Some locations of the Drain may require stabilizing eroding or damaged drain banks.

What do I need to do?
We need to hear from you! Because we are performing work on or near your property it is important that you contact us. If you have or think you may have items/structures (shed, house, fence, etc.) within 30 feet of the Drain, we need to hear from you as soon as possible!
