Circumstance: APPD was dispatched to Ecorse/Pelham for an accident, with possibly an involved party fleeing the scene. Upon arrival, the Officer observed a disabled Audi S5 (MI PLATE: in the roadway on Ecorse Rd, West of Pelham. The Officer spoke with the driver, who advised the striking vehicle was parked at 19347 Ecorse Rd, Papa's Pizza. The Officer observed a W/M wearing a black shirt walking around the truck, then walking down the sidewalk and around the building of 19309 Ecorse Rd, Critters Pet Shop. The Officer made his way over there, with emergency lights active. The Officer turned on S/B Robinson from Ecorse and observed the male in question running S/B Robinson on the sidewalk. When the Officer turned on Robinson, the male stopped running and put his hands in the air. The

Officer drew his taser and ordered the male to ground, in which he complied. The male was handcuffed, TC/DL, and detained. The male, identified as OF began stating he ran because he "already has multiple DUI's" and is "scared". He was placed in the rear of my patrol vehicle and transported back to the scene. While being transported, he freely stated he had been drinking, and was coming from Mt. Clemens for a beer league softball game. He advised he had approximately 7-8 beers. The strong odor of intoxicants emanated from his person, his eyes were bloodshot and glossy, and he was slurring his words. He secured in the rear of the patrol vehicle, and the admission of consuming alcohol, it was determined SFST's would not be given. A PBT was offered and refused to take it. He was advised he was under arrest for OWI and Obstruction, and transported to APPD. Once at APPD, the Officer read, verbatim, his DI-177 Chemical Test Rights, in which he agreed to

take a breath test at 0109Hrs. A 15 minute observation period began and at the end took the Datamaster breath test. The first result of the Datamaster was a .16BAC at 0126Hrs, the second result of the Datamaster was a .15BAC at 0129Hrs. He was booked and housed at APPD without incident. All applicable OWI paperwork was completed and filed accordingly. The MI Plate: was confiscated and tagged as evidence, and a repeat offender plate was issued in place. DCD entered the repeat offender plate into LEIN. He is not the registered owner, nor the primary driver of the vehicle, and the vehicle was not forfeited at this time. DNA was taken from him and was placed in the out-going mailbox. The Officer completed the UD-10 for the crash, see the UD-10 for crash information. The above listed vehicle was entered into LEIN as impounded, citations were issued at this time due to the OWI 3rd Felony charge.

## Cabrini to hold Second Annual Hall of Fame Day

The Cabrini High School Alumni Association will hold its second annual Hall of Fame Day on Thursday, June 15. This event honors elite alum athletes who distinguished themselves during their high school and/or post-high school athletic careers. The day will include a morning golf outing at Lakes of Taylor and an evening induction banquet at Crystal Park Banquet Center in Allen Park. The banquet will also feature the special presentation of Cabrini's highest honor, the Summa Honore Award.

The alumni association will induct the 1976 Girl's Basketball State Champion team and four alum athletes, adding to the elite group inducted at last year's inaugural event.

The 2023 Hall of Fame Inductees include:

Joe Lubaway '69

Joe was a standout athlete at Cabrini, excelling in football and track. He was named the 1969 Male Athlete of the Year, was a member of the school's first Championship football team in 1967, and received All Downriver, All Catholic, and All-State honors twice. In addition, he held the school shot put record and was awarded a football scholarship to Eastern Michigan University, where he played in the Pioneer Bowl in 1971.

Gloria Joseph '70 Gloria excelled in basketball and softball while a student at Cabrini. She was named the 1970 Female Athlete of the Year and, in 2002, was named one of the Catholic High School League's top 50 Female Athletes in league history. In addition, she was a CHSL Hall of Fame inductee in 1989 for officiating. Gloria officiated in 12 CHSL final games in softball

and baseball. Also, she participated in five MHSAA state finals assignments in softball and basketball, as well as an NCAA Division 1 Regional Tournament and NCAA Division 3 National Tournaments as an official.

Terry Andrysiak '84 Terry was a highly-recognized football standout while he attended Cabrini and was named the 1984 Male Athlete of the Year. He was football captain his senior year and received All League, All Area, and All Catholic Honors in his sophomore, junior and senior years. He was named to the All-State Dream Team in his junior and senior years and received the Adidas Scholastic All-American award in his senior year. Terry was awarded a football scholarship to Notre Dame University, where he earned the Chevrolet Player of the Game in 1987 after the Notre Dame

vs. Michigan game. He played four seasons with the Canadian Football League.

Katie Osburn Eaton '08 Katie was a two-time Cabrini State Champion softball team member. She was named All-State in Softball during her sophomore, junior and senior years and set a record for allowing only one run the entire season. She holds the state record for 80 consecutive victories in '06 - '08 and was named Miss Softball in 2008 by the Michigan High School Softball Coaches Association. She played Division 1 softball at Miami University.

After the induction of these outstanding athletes, the 2023 Summa Honore Award will be presented. Tim Kluka has been named the second recipient of this prestigious award that recognizes exceptional personal achievement and service that reflects the core val-

ues of Cabrini.

Kluka has a 50-year relationship with the Cabrini community wearing many hats through the years.
