Circumstance:

On the above date APPD was dispatched to the listed location for a retail fraud in progress. While en route APPD was informed by DCD that the above offenders had just committed a retail fraud and were fleeing in a black Ford SUV toward Outer Drive.

An Officer checked Outer Drive EB and observed a vehicle matching that description. The Officer was further informed that the male suspect was wearing a black t-shirt and the female was wearing a pink t-shirt. The Officer conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle and observed a W/M and W/F in the back seat matching the description of the two suspects given over the radio. At that time the Officer detained both subjects for the remainder of the investigation. The Officer asked what had occurred at Meijer and she stated that she did not know and that all the items in the car were paid for. She continually denied knowing that any merchandise had been stolen. The Officer then spoke to the other party, who also stated that all the merchandise was paid for. Neither party was able to provide any proof of purchase for the items. Meijer LPO, he stated that he observed the two suspects, enter the store together. Both subjects began shopping and selecting assorted merchandise and placing it in

their cart. Then they observed them going to the checkout and scan three items (Popsicles) which totaled \$10.25. He said that, they paid for these items and placed them back into the cart on top of all the other assorted merchandise. They then pushed the cart past all points of purchase without offering any form of payment for the remainder of the items in his cart. He said he then attempted to stop them in the vestibule of the store to ask him about the unpaid merchandise but they ignored him and continued out of the store to his vehicle. According to security, he also confronted the other party but she also continued out of the store to the same vehicle the other one went to. LPO then observed the vehicle flee the scene. They completed an LPO report. There are also photos and CCTV footage of the incident. All stolen merchandise was recovered. They and were both cited for Retail Fraud and released from the scene. The Meijer LPO report was placed in the DB box.
