

WCRC Continues to Provide "Critical Infrastructure" Services

On Monday, Governor Whitmer issued the Stay Home, Stay Safe, Save Lives Order, directing all Michigan businesses and operations to temporarily suspend in-person operations that are not necessary to sustain or protect life for the next 3 weeks.

The governor has ordered all Michiganders to stay in their homes unless:

- They're a part of that critical infrastructure workforce
- Engaged in an outdoor activity

• Performing tasks necessary to the health and safety of themselves or their family, like going to the hospital or grocery store

As part of the "critical infrastructure workforce", the Washtenaw County Road Commission will continue to provide services to the traveling public. The tasks WCRC staff do every day help sustain critical infrastructure for emergency responders, those delivering essential supplies and others

email wrcr@wcroads.org with questions. Phone and email will be monitored remotely by WCRC staff, Monday – Thursday, 6 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.

WCRC's lobby remains closed to the public until further notice. Critical deliveries can still be made to the shop at WCRC's main yard, 555 N. Zeeb Road. There are still many ways to conduct business with WCRC remotely, for example:

- Apply for right-of-way permits
- Apply for trans-

portation permits

- Report a non-emergency road issue

As of right now, construction projects will continue as planned but all personnel have been instructed to practice social distancing while on the job site.

American 1 Closes Remaining Lobbies & Changes Hours

In an email message sent yesterday afternoon to members of American 1 Credit Union, the credit union's President/CEO Martha Fuerstenau announced that, beginning March 21, American 1's operating hours will be reduced to the hours of 9am-1pm, Monday through Saturday. All branches lobbies that remained open after a partial lobby closure this past Monday will also close to the public beginning Monday, March 23. All drive thru and digital services continue operating to serve members.

“Up until this point, we have done our best to keep as many locations open as possible to provide continued service to members, while still keeping a safe and healthy space for employees,” stated Fuerstenau in the email. “Unfortunately we've reached the point where we can no longer balance those

things.”

American 1 is currently operating at about 40% of regular staffing due to COVID-19. According to the email, the credit union shortened their hours out of necessity to keep staff healthy and prevent burnout. The new operating hours were chosen to line up with the hours of some local grocery stores in hopes people who are running errands will complete their banking at the same time.

American 1 is equipped to handle the majority of essential banking services remotely through Online Banking, the American 1 Mobile App (with mobile check deposit), their 24-hour Contact Center and other self-service options.

Member cash needs can be met with drive thru services, open 9am-1pm Monday through Saturday, and American 1's extensive network of ATMs. The Amer-

ican 1 website is continuously updated to maintain a current listing of all operating drive thru and ATM locations. American 1 credit and debit cards will experience no interruption in service and the Contact Center will be available to assist with any issues that might be encountered.

“American 1 Credit Union is financially strong and your deposits are safe and sound,” continued Fuerstenau. “We must also keep our employees safe and sound in order to continue to serve you.”



Any current or future clients should call 475-3305 with any questions, or if you have concerns about food access given these changes. Leave a message if necessary. Hours of operation are also the best time to make any food donations. Please leave food donations outside the doors and call to notify staff who will also check periodically. If needed, receipts can be sent later so leave a note with your contact information inside your donation bag. As always, financial donations provide most of our operating funds. This health event will increase our need for the coming months which makes your donation more important than ever. Funds allow us to maintain services during this emergency as we keep food on our shelves, address emergency needs, and maintain critical staffing levels. Donations
